BE CHECKED

THERE IS NO SELECTION PROCESS BY MAELOR RIDING CLUB - IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO ENTER THEN PLEASE DO!

WE WILL PUT TEAMS TOGETHER SO YOU CAN ENTER A TEST IN THE NOVICE /OPEN TEAM COMPETITIONS AND I WILL TRY AND MAKE AS MANY TEAMS AS POSSIBLE.

PLEASE NOTE THAT YOU CAN PUT TOGETHER YOUR OWN TEAM BUT PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOU ASK THEM AND THAT BOTH HORSE AND RIDER ARE ELIBGIBLE.

Reminder of Rules:

G6.3 HORSES MAY NOT COMPETE TWICE

No horse may compete more than once in the same British riding clubs competition. Except as in rule G6.3. *A horse may not compete in the novice and opens sections in the same discipline at an official BRC competition in the same competition year.*

E.g you cannot do the Prelim 14(novice team) and then the Novice tests or Elementary (open team) on the same day as qualifiers but you can do a prelim Qualifier and a Novice test as a non- qualifier or vice versa (this applies to seniors only)

TEAM DRESSAGE – COMPETING MORE THAN ONCE

Competitors in the open team dressage may compete in more than one test on the same horse provided that each test is different and only one test is as a team member.

G6.2 DOWNGRADING OF WINNINGS

Applications for downgrading points or winnings will be considered on an individual basis. Forns are available on the BRC website. Winnings which have previously been downgraded , as per prior rules, will be honoured

Downgraded horses and Ponies that have ever won a dressage point are NOT eligible for the Novice team dressage competition

Just to clarify you can ride the Prelim 14 and Riding Test, Pairs and the Rural Riders all as qualifiers but you cannot ride the Prelim or any of the Novice Tests as qualifiers on the same day. But you can ride the Novice tests as a non-qualifier confused just ring Anne Dawson on 01948 841329 and I will try to explain.

Juniors Team dressage consists of 2 x Prelim 14 and 2x Novice 27 . Ind Elem 40

ALL SO ANY HORSE HAVING DONE THE MEDIUM QUALIFIER AT ANY TIME IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE NOVICE TEAM,(prelim tests) EVEN IF THE HORSE HAS NO BD POINTS.

All tests are for Juniors and seniors, Juniors can only do N27.N30, N34, M73 as non Qualifiers
